- d) Purpose of the Collection of Personal Information
 - Our company, in principle, uses personal information within the scope of the following purposes. If other purposes of use are specified on individual pages of this website, those purposes are included.
 - (1) To register customer information and open an account for this service.
 - (2) To send notifications related to our service provision, such as billing, suspension, or contract termination, based on the contract.
